ABOUT OMÜ-YÖS...

• International Student Entrance Examination (OMU-YÖS) can be taken by international students wishing to study at Ondokuz Mayıs University (OMU) of Turkey. OMU-YÖS results can be used in the application process for admission to OMU and 115 other universities including 71 state and 46 private ones.

• OMU-YÖS applications will be made completely online and candidates will be able to apply in Turkish, English, Russian, German, French, Arabic, Bosnian or Albanian.

• OMU-YÖS exam will take place in exam centers located in Turkey and other countries on a fully controlled, face to face basis and will be in 8 languages: Turkish, English, Russian, German, French, Arabic, Bosnian or Albanian.

• The examination will be held in one sitting.

• OMU-YÖS results are valid for a period of two years.

WHO CAN APPLY?

On condition of being a final year high school student or being a high school graduate;

• Foreign nationals,

• Those who are Turkish citizens by birth but ceased to be a citizen of Turkey with the permission of the Ministry of Internal Affairs; and the under aged children of such people who are registered in their parent's document of alienage and can certify that they have the "Document Regarding the Exercise of Rights Given by Law" which is obtained in accordance with the Turkish Nationality Law,

• Those who were foreign nationals and acquired Turkish citizenship afterwards; and dual citizens who comply with these criteria,

• Turkish nationals who have been continuing their secondary education in a foreign country before 01.02.2013 and have completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country other than the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), (including the ones who have completed their secondary education [high school] in Turkish schools located in foreign countries other than the TRNC and opened by the permission of the Ministry of National Education).

• Turkish nationals who have started their secondary education in a foreign country after 01.02.2013 and have completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country other than the

Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), (including the ones who have completed their secondary education [high school] in Turkish schools located in foreign countries other than the TRNC and opened by the permission of Ministry of National Education).

• TRNC nationals who reside in TRNC and have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have the GCE AL exam score and those who have registered in a college or high school in other countries between 2005 – 2010 and received education in these schools and have or will have the GCE AL exam score.

WHO CANNOT APPLY?

• Those who are Turkish Citizens and have completed their entire secondary education in Turkey or TRNC (the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus).

• Those who are TRNC Citizens (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have the GCE AL exam score and those who have registered in a college or high school in other countries between 2005 – 2010 and received education in these schools and have or will have the GCE AL exam score).

• Those who have dual nationalities and their first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in the sub clause (b), Paragraph 5, Clause 5 (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country other than TRNC / those who have completed their entire secondary education in a Turkish school in a foreign country other than TRNC).

• Those who have dual nationalities and either of them is TRNC (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have the GCE AL exam score and those who have registered in a college or high school in other countries between 2005 – 2010 and received education in these schools and have or will have the GCE AL exam score).

• Those who are Turkish citizens and have studied in schools within the body of embassies in Turkey or those who are Turkish citizens or who have dual nationalities and their first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in the sub clause (b), Paragraph 5, Clause 5 and have studied in one of the foreign high schools located in Turkey.

HOW CAN YOU APPLY TO OMÜ-YÖS 2017?

Applications will be accepted between 02 January – 31 March 2017. Online pre-registration and exact registration processes will be carried out online through <http://ais.uzem.omu.edu.tr> within the specified time period for applications. Right after the pre-registration process

candidates will be sent details about their registrations to their e-mail addresses.

Exact registration processes will be completed with the directives sent to the e-mails of the candidates through <http://ise.omu.edu.tr>. At this stage, the candidate has to specify the exam language and exam center where the exam will be taken.

Candidates are required to upload a front face photograph in "jpeg" format which easily identifies the person. The photograph should be taken within the last three (3) months.

Payment of the exam fee:

The Exam fee can only be paid via credit card during online application

WHEN WILL THE EXAM ENTRANCE DOCUMENTS BE SENT?

The "Exam Entrance Document" including the language of the exam, address and contact information of the exam center will be downloaded at the end of the application date through the online application website.

Please do not forget to bring your "Exam Entrance Document" and passport information (or a relevant id document) to the exam center!

How are The Exam Results Evaluated?

OMÜ-YÖS 2017 will be evaluated in three separate categories: Basic Learning Skills, Mathematics and Equal Weight. Number of false answers will not affect the total number of correct answers.



QUESTIONS

Can I apply without a passport?

Candidates may apply with an identification number. But please bear in mind that a passport is mandatory for going abroad. You cannot enter another country without a passport.

Can I change the exam center? The exam center cannot be changed after the deadline.

LEGAL ISSUES

The candidates are responsible for the accuracy of the information they provide during the online registration for the OMU-YÖS 2016 exam. False declarations, false pretences, actions against the exam rules and such behavior result in the disqualification of the exam result and legal and administrative action will be initiated.
